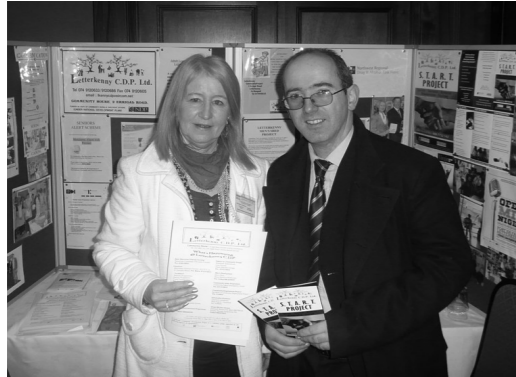

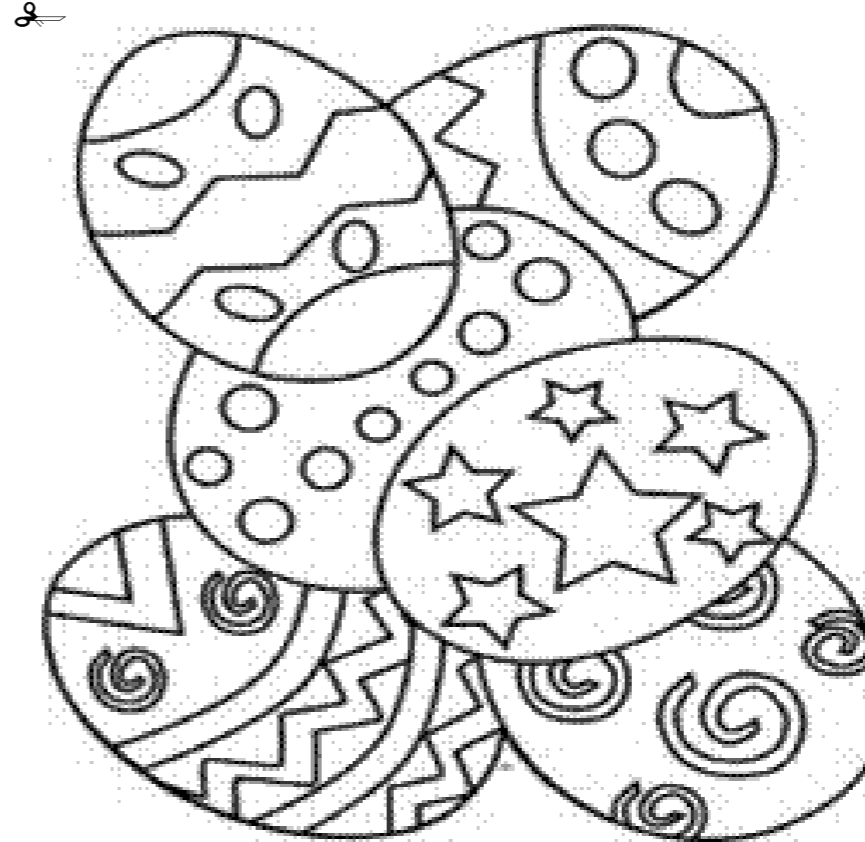
SENIOR ALERT PROGRAMME:

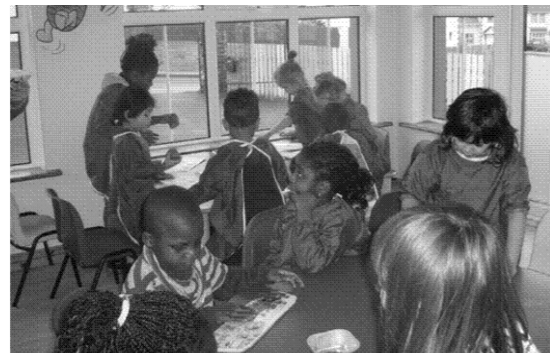

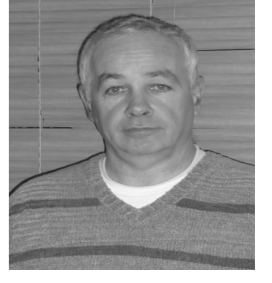
